***The President's Pleasure***

Another Solstice is behind us. The dying Sun has been reborn and with the returning light our thoughts turn to... presidential politics? Well that's where mine turned recently. The topic has, after all, been hard to avoid during the past few weeks, and I recently spent a week in Florida near West Palm Beach, where the controversy over the election results is still an open wound.

What draws my attention, now that the drama over, the transition of power has reached its denouement, and our new leader has established his precarious tenure, is the timing of the event. The old ruler submits to the sovereignty of the new between Yule and Imbolc. As the new sun grows stronger, the new president firms up cabinet appointments and consolidates influence over lesser luminaries in the concentric orbits of the Beltway.

Can this be anything other than a modern reenactment of the primeval rites of king-killing documented so copiously and enthusiastically by Sir James Frazer in his classic work, The Golden Bough? Even the mandatory limit to eight years in office (a tradition established by Washington himself, though not codified in law until after FDR) is accounted for by Frazer. Eight years was the normal length of the king's reign in Sparta and other parts of Greece because "an octennial cycle is the shortest period at the end of which the sun and moon ... mark time together .... [I]t is only once in every eight years that the full moon coincides with the longest or shortest day."

Thus our electoral sideshow has roots which reach back farther than our founding fathers knew, despite their Masonic pedigrees. Instead of displaying the ten commandments at our schools and courthouses we should be posting copies of The Golden Bough. It provides much better

insight into our system of government. In the meantime, let us join our fellow citizens in offering this year's solar sacrifice. The king is dead! Long live the king!
